Minutes of the Meeting of Langsett Parish Council held at The Barn, Langsett on Wednesday 11th March 2026 at 7.00pm

25/26-112 Apologies for absence

25/26 -117 Recent "Rave" event at Flouch

Cllr Horner attended a meeting with South Yorkshire Police and Cllr Kitching. There will be increased social media posts, alerts and patrols for the next Bank Holidays to try to dissuade organisers from using the Langsett area. If residents see anything, advice is to ring the Police or the Fire Brigade if a fire is spotted.

25/26 -118 Installation of Fibre Broadband

The Chair expressed the disappointment and frustration of residents who have been waiting for an installation date in January as many have renewed with suppliers waiting for confirmation of the installation date. There have been mixed messages given regarding the installation date within the village. Recently the installation date was stated as October, rather than late Spring. Mr Parks and Mr Furnass explained that there was an issue at Fulshaw Cross, and a response awaited from BMBC to try to clear this area, expecting reply by 18th March. January was a provisional date and these issues/delays were not anticipated. The end date was October 2026 but it is hoped that the road traffic order may be in place by April. Ward Cllr Kitching will check the current position at BMBC. The Chair thanked Mr Parks and Mr Furnass for the update.
